On behalf of Mr Aheer and the members of the Greytown Feeding Project we thank you for your generous donation of 3000 Euros to be utilised by the project in the distribution of grocery hampers to approximately 200 people per month during the period of June to September 2017. We would also like to utilise some of the money in purchasing a photo-copier, some utensis for the kitchen chairs for the frail and sick to sit on when waiting in the queue for food and or hampers and remuneration for our volunteers. We therefore humbly request that some of the money received can also be used for the above listed items and therefore await your response regarding this request.

The Greytown Feeding project is a non-profit (NPO), public benefit organization (PBO) that is based in Greytown, the district of Umvoti in KwaZulu-Natal, South Africa and is registered with the Department Of Social Services. D.R. Aheer has chaired the project since 2002 and is currently assisted by a committee of 17 members. The organisation was initiated in 2002 by a small group of volunteers andhas been in operation since then. About 2000 people were being fed on a monthly basis at the Greytown Community Centre which at that time was being rented by the Project on a Tuesday and Thursday for the serving of meals. Unfortunately this venue was not permanent and in July 2005 land was purchased to build a feeding hall. The building was eventually completed on the 09thof June 2016 and the continuation of feeding took place for the first time at this permanent venue.

We have 5 devout volunteers who help in the preparation of food and the cleaning up every Tuesday and Thursday and 5 more who assist in the serving of food and crowd control. The functioning of the Feeding Project relies on the goodwill of volunteers and its operating costs are met solely through the generous donations we receive from the public and local business houses.

The primary objective of the Feeding project is to provide nutritious meals to the hungry, poor, sick,homeless, disabled and indigent members of the Umvoti community. We feed about 200 people every Tuesday and Thursday, our meals range from veg briyani, samp and beans and occasionally tinned fish curry and/or chicken.
